

## Roussanne 2020

Bright straw to pale yellow. Lots of spiced pear and yellow peach to begin with almond and lemon zest chiming in. The palate is medium to full, with generous fruit weight and texture. All underpinned by guiding acidity and a lingering finish.

### Varieties

100% Roussanne

### Terroir

Granite soil that sits over layers of ancient river gravel in the Box Grove vineyards in Nagambie, Victoria, on Taungurung land.

### Viticulture

Grapes grown by Sarah Gough of the Box Grove vineyard. She uses her own compost and focuses on well aerated canopy to reduce the need for sulphur and copper.

### Vintage Notes

A warm and fairly dry start to the year pushed the modest crop towards a potential early harvest. Mild weather from late February along with some decent rain slowed ripening and allowed picking to commence under cooler conditions.

### Yield

Two tonnes/acre

### Vintage Date

13 March 2020

### Vinification

Hand picked and whole bunch pressed. Fermented with indigenous yeast in French oak barrels.

### Ageing

12 months in oak on lees, five months in stainless on light lees. No stirring. Racked just before bottling.

### Bottling Date

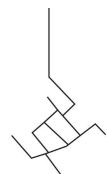
